

RULES OF USE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS FOR OUR POOLS

We're delighted to welcome you to our swimming pool. The pools are a place for sport, playing,

fun and recreation. Attention and caution are required in order to ensure that a visit to the swimming pool is safe and fun for all guests. The following information is intended to help you in this:

Hygiene

1. The swimming pool may only be used in swimwear.

You may not use the pool wearing underwear, jogging pants or similar.

- 2. Outdoor shoes may not be worn in the pool area.
- 3. Please shower thoroughly before entering the swimming pool.

Safety for you and others

- 4. The pool may only be used by confident swimmers.
- The deep water is dangerous for non-swimmers. Please do not overestimate your strength and capabilities.

There is a risk of drowning!

- Pay special attention to the transition between the non-swimmer and swimmer areas. If you are unsure of where this transition is, ask our staff.
- 5. Children are at particular risk in and around the water.
- Parents or other suitable companions must supervise the children at all times!
- Children can drown even in shallow water.
- Children who can't swim must wear water wings or other buoyancy aids. Please note that

buoyancy aids cannot provide absolute safety.

- 6. Do not jump from the side of the pool.
- Please use only the starting blocks and diving facilities for jumping into the water.

Jumping in from the side of the pool is prohibited.

- The diving facilities may only be used after they have been opened by our staff.
- Once the diving facilities have been opened, swimming underneath the diving boards is prohibited. Please make sure before every dive that there are no swimmers in the water below the diving boards.
- 7. The floors in the pool area are wet and slippery please walk slowly. Walking quickly or running is not allowed in the pool area.

Consideration for other guests

8. Other pool guests – irrespective of age, gender or origin – must be treated with respect

and consideration!

- 9. Please be extra considerate of children and the elderly.
- 10. Taking photographs of strangers in the facility is prohibited.

Lockers and keys

- 11. You will need a €1 coin to use the lockers and safety deposit boxes. You will get the coin back when you unlock the locker / deposit box.
- 12. Locker keys must be kept in a safe place. If lost, a replacement fee will be charged.

The House and Bathing Rules are binding for all guests

- 13. The pool staff are your contact partners and are happy to assist you.
- 14. The staff exercise domiciliary rights: the instructions of all employees must always be followed!
- 15. The House and Bathing Rules apply to every visitor to the pool; these can be viewed at the cash desk.

In the event of non-compliance, the pool management reserves the right to issue a house ban.

Special rules apply to the sauna!

Guests are not permitted to enter the sauna just to look around.
